

ABOUT LANCE RANDALL:



Lance Randall is in his 3rd year as head coach of the Lindenwood Lions men's basketball team. Randall's tenure has been highlighted with the program's first NCAA regional ranking, first

MIAA Tournament victory, most DII wins in a season, the first 20-win season in the DII era, and five all-conference player recognitions in his first two seasons alone.

Prior to arriving at Lindenwood, Randall coached at the high school, collegiate, and professional levels. His coaching accolades include 9 conference championships, 7 NCAA tournament appearances, 2 Sweet 16's, 1 NCAA National Championship, 2 NIT tournament appearances, 6 Coach of the Year awards, 2 Wisconsin High School State Championships, and 7 nationally ranked teams.

Randall's career also includes international experience having professionally coached in over 20 countries and former players competing in over 25. Over the course of his career, Randall has developed 48 all-conference players, 8 conference POY award winners, 14 All-American's, 2 Wisconsin State POY award winners, and a National Academic All-American of the Year. In addition to facilitating player development, Randall's teams have excelled in the classroom by maintaining a cumulative team GPA above 3.0 every year.

Mandatory Waiver: (individual waivers needed for multiple family members)

1.) In signing this Release, Waiver, and Hold Harmless, I acknowledge and represent that I have read the foregoing document, acknowledge that I have the right to review it with my own legal counsel, understand it, and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed. No oral representations, statements, or inducements apart from the foregoing agreement that has been reduced to writing have been made. I execute this document for full, adequate and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by the same, now and in the future.

6.) All other terms notwithstanding, this document does not release, and expressly excludes from its terms, claims, liabilities, or causes of action which are non-releasable under State or Federal Laws, including, but not limited to, intentional torts, gross recklessness, gross negligence, fraud, or activities involving the public interest, depending on the jurisdiction.
